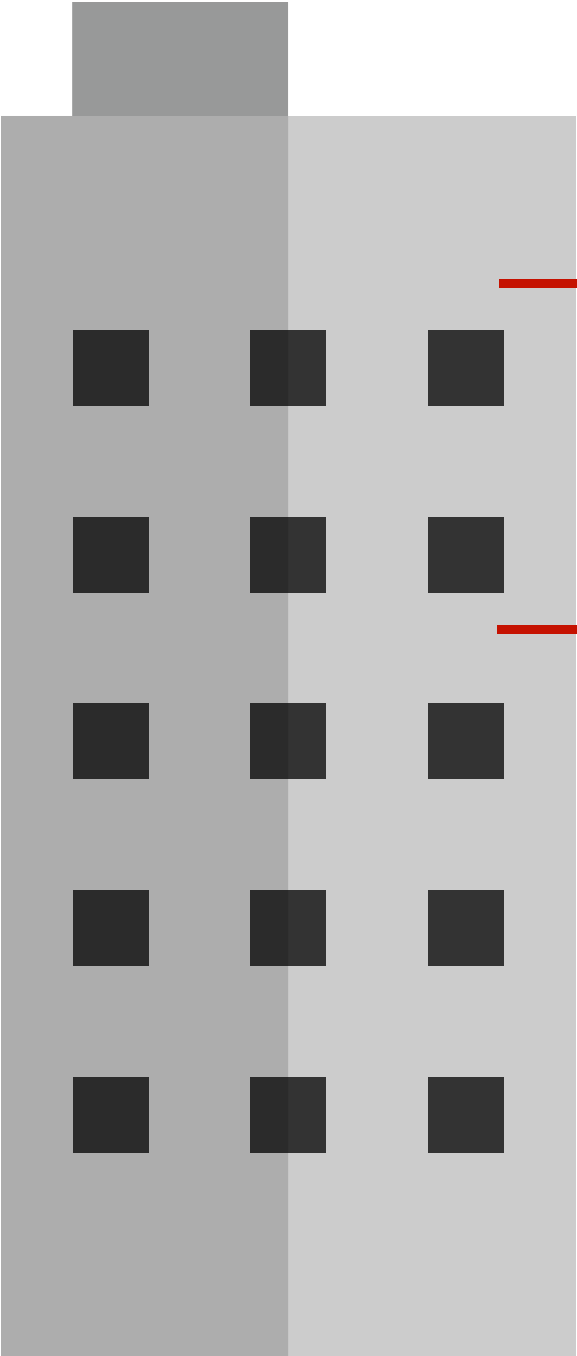


# TORONTO ACORN'S AFFORDABLE CITY CAMPAIGN



1

30% of new developments should be affordable to low and moderate income earners; 40% around transit nodes.

Housing is affordable if it costs less than 30% of a household's annual income before tax

3

Of the 30-40% affordable units:

25%

Should be affordable to extremely low-income households (Incomes less than \$19,999)

0-20% of AMI\*

50%

Should be affordable to low-income households (Incomes of \$20,000 to \$39,999)

20-60% of AMI\*

25%

Should be affordable to moderate-income households (Incomes of \$40,000 to \$69,999)

60-100% of AMI\*

\*AMI is the area median income  
Toronto's AMI was \$65,829 in 2015
