Principles and Foundations of Community Unionism and ACORN

- 1) Growth: If you're not growing, you are dying
- 2) Self-sufficiency ensures survival whoever pays controls!
- **3) Co-ordinated autonomy** is key: we balance local autonomy with national co-ordination on campaigns.
- 4) Issues are a **vehicle for building more power**. We aren't afraid to fight! No single issue is the sole goal.
- **5) Actions** are crucial and the lifeblood of the organization. Collective Action Works!
- **6)** Leadership is shared and functional; every member has leadership potential. Organize against conflict. Work on issues that unite us!
- 7) Accountability: ACORN is owned by its members and democratically elected leaders.




